Update about St. Mary's School staying closed:

Recently Governor Little posted his latest guideline for opening communities (see **Rebound.Idaho.Gov**). Regarding schools opening though he deferred to the Idaho State Board of Education's April 16, 2020, guidelines for reopening.

We (Administrative Team with Fr. Joe) have reviewed the guidelines. We reviewed our local Moscow guidelines established by Mayor Lambert and Moscow City Council and Dr. Beller was in communication with the District 2 Health Department.

- Based on the soft closure re-entry criteria:
- No children in schools until at least May 4th, perhaps longer,
- The requirement of a minimum six-foot social distancing through the middle of June,
- Development of a plan for vulnerable staff and students with a special emphasis on people over age 60 and those who are medically vulnerable,

We at St. Mary's Parish School will be in compliance with the directives and continue our soft closure until the end of the current school year.


