As a school in Idaho (with a childcare program), we are required to follow the guidelines of: Governor Little, State Board of Education, the Diocese of Boise and our insurance company, Catholic Mutual.

Presently, we have entered *Stage Two* (May 16-29) of the guidelines: No more than 10 may gather and Social distancing of 6 feet.
